Dr. Derek & Mrs. Marsha King MMK Scholarship Eligibility Criteria

For the Dr. Derek & Mrs. King MMK Scholarship, student applicants will demonstrate a continuing commitment to service in Aviation, Military, Healthcare, Education or other closely related fields. Because the King's believe that we can enrich our communities through community service and advocacy, the Selection Committee will take a strong interest in applicants that have a history of community service and/or involvement in Aviation, Military, Healthcare, Education clubs or organizations.

Essav

As part of the application for the Dr. & Mrs. King MMK Scholarship, applicants are required to write *an original* essay. Note: You are cautioned against simply "recycling" personal essays used for college applications or other scholarships.

In 500 typed words or less, describe "How do you plan to impact your community from the knowledge learned through Millionaire Mind Kids?" Your essay should provide insight into your current achievements, your expectations for future study and career choices, and how you intend to give back to your community.

Dr. & Mrs. King MMK Scholarships Requirements

The following application requirements apply to all Millionaire Mind Kids applicants, you are strongly advised to read the application form carefully to ensure that you understand and follow any specific directions for the scholarship.

Eligible Students

The Dr. & Mrs. King MMK Scholarship Program welcomes applications from Millionaire Mind Kids students in the High Desert region:

- Who are between the ages of 18 years old and 24 years old" eligible students will be at least 18 years old by June 30, 2025, and no older than 24 years old by July 1, 2025"
- Who are graduating high school seniors with *a minimum* 2.75 GPA on a 4.00 scale, or who are continuing enrolled post-secondary students with *a minimum* 2.75 GPA on a 4.00 scale, AND
- Who are graduating from *regionally accredited* public or private high schools by July 1, 2025" eligible students include those graduating from charter high schools, religiously affiliated high schools or home schools or home school programs in the High Desert region and which are *regionally accredited*" OR
- Who are enrolled in a regionally accredited post-secondary institution.

 Note: students enrolled in or planning to attend an institution that is **not** regionally accredited are **not** eligible for consideration for the scholarship.
- All students must be residents of California for *at least* three (3) years and who are graduating or have graduated from a regionally accredited high school in the High Desert region.

Official/Certified Transcripts are required of all students as part of the application package. Before the scholarship is awarded to the successful applicant, a final Official Transcript will be required to be submitted to DVL Project (scholarship administrator). Applicants graduating from high school also must include a "letter of acceptance" from the institution they plan to attend. Applicants currently enrolled in a post: secondary institution must present evidence of "academic progress" from an institutional official at the counselor level or above from the institution in which they are enrolled.

Institution Accreditation. For applicants to be eligible for the Dr. & Mrs. King Scholarship, all education institutions to be considered by applicants or in which they are enrolled must be "Regionally accredited." Accreditation information usually can be obtained from the Registrar of the institution.

Original Essay. Write an original essay as directed in the first part of this application.
